Coaches

Dates

Season Dates: Monday, May 13th to Thursday, July 2nd, every Monday and Thursday from 6:30 to 7:30 PM at Fort Niagara.

Bumblebee Start Date: Monday, May 13th, every Monday and Thursday from 6:30 to 7:00 PM at Fort Niagara.

Equipment Info

Provided: Team jersey, pair of socks, coaches provided with some soccer balls and cones, end of season medal.

Suggested Equipment to Bring Every Game/Practice: Soccer shoes, shorts, soccer ball (size 3 Bumblebees - PeeWees, size 4 Internationals), water, sunscreen. Coaches will give each player a jersey and a pair of socks on the first day of practice.

Playing Schedule

Bumblebees: Bumblebees will participate in soccer oriented activities for 30 minutes. There will be no game schedule, however near the end of the season, coaches and teams are more than welcome to try and facilitate a real game!

All Other Divisions: All teams will practice for the whole hour during the first two weeks of the season. After the first two weeks, a game schedule will be sent to all coaches and players with designated field locations. As this is a house league program, game results will not be recorded, and there will be no overall division "champion."

Team/Coach Requests

The house league coordinator will do their best to meet all requests, they are not guaranteed. NPSL tries to ensure that teams are balanced and fair.

Field Locations

Bumblebees are playing behind the green Kickwall between fields 5 and 6, Blizzards are on field 6, Pee Wees are on field 5, and the International division will be on fields 3 and 4. See House League Map [here](#)

Parking

Please do not park close to the service road entrance south of the tobogganing hill. In the event of an emergency, first response personnel will need clear access to fields. Parking at the Fort is also free in the evenings. Please park in the designated lots at Fort Niagara. **Do NOT park on the grass immediately adjacent to the fields.** Park Police will ticket cars that are not parked in the lots. Be extremely alert of young athletes crossing the road as they are excited to play soccer.

Weather Policy

Unless there is a severe thunderstorm warning, soccer has and will continue to be played even with moderate to heavy rainfall. If soccer is ever canceled due to inclement weather, an email will be sent out to all parents and coaches by 5:30 pm the day of.
